

Examination Rules

1. Candidates will be in their allotted places at least 15 minutes before commencement of each session of the examination.
2. Each candidate shall satisfy the Invigilator as to his/her personal identity.
3. No person may come into the examination room after half an hour of the commencement of the examination.
4. Candidates have 2 1/2 hours to complete each booklet and are required to remain in the examination room for the first hour after the start of the examination.
5. Candidates must not communicate with one another in any manner during the examination. In the event of any form of communication between candidates, it will be the duty of the Invigilator, if he or she obtained clear evidence of the fact at the time of its occurrence, to cause such candidate(s) to leave the room and not re-admit that candidate(s) during any further part of the examination. The Invigilator shall, on the day the incident occurs, write out a full report stating the facts and submit same to the Executive Director of the C.R.P.N.M.
6. The booklets comprising the CRPNM Registration Examination contain multiple choice questions which must be answered on the Test Response sheets as directed.
7. Candidates must not ask the Invigilators to interpret any question on the examination, or to give any information whatsoever concerning any part or whole of the examination. Should an error appear to be contained in any question, no attention shall be drawn to it at the time. Candidates may give notice of same in writing to the CRPNM.
8. Each candidate will be furnished with one copy of the Examination test booklet only, for each part of the examination.
9. All test booklets, answer sheets and any spare paper used must be handed to the Invigilators prior to leaving the examination room.
10. Any candidate found guilty of violating these rules will be liable for the cancellation of his whole examination or such other penalty as the CRPNM should deem fit.
11. Personal effects such as purses, books, etc. must be left with the Invigilators during the examination sessions.
12. A candidate who leaves the examination room without permission will not be permitted re-entry during that segment of the examination.
13. Candidates are to seat themselves with as much room as possible between.
