We recognize that there may be circumstances where in-person appointments at the CRPNM building is beneficial or required.

Our office is open to visitors by appointment only.

All visitors must adhere to the most recent Public Health Orders. Visitors will be required to wear a mask and provide proof of vaccination status. Acceptable forms of proof will be the digital (QR code) or physical Manitoba Immunization Card.

Individuals who are not able to be vaccinated for medical reasons, or who choose not to be vaccinated, are invited to make a virtual appointment.

If you have an appointment at the CRPNM office at 1854 Portage Avenue in Winnipeg, we require that you follow the practices outlined below for your safety and for the safety of the College employees.

In Advance of the Meeting:

All visitors must follow the standards and procedures set by the College which include using the COVID-19 Screening Tool developed by Shared Health. Arriving at the College:

The College requires all visitors to sign in and out of the building at the main reception desk and to provide their contact information for tracing purposes.

Hand sanitizer will be available. You will be required to sanitize your hands on entering and exiting the building. A disposable mask will be provided if you do not have one. The mask must be worn at all times.

Proof of vaccination status will be required. Acceptable forms of proof will be the digital (QR code) or physical Manitoba Immunization Card.

Physical Distancing:

You will be required to ensure physical distancing of two (2) meters with others. Please follow the markings on the floor. If your appointment is in one of our staff offices, the room will be set up to ensure physical distancing of two (2) meters.

If you are in the hallway and see another person enter, please indicate where you are going so everyone can manage their personal space to maintain physical distancing.
