

Financial Assistance for International Educated Nurses (IEN)

As you may be aware, the Province of Manitoba has launched an initiative to help internationally educated nurses (IENs) in Manitoba with financial assistance for numerous costs related to the assessment and recognition process that leads to practice.

IENs may be eligible for up to \$23,000 for a range of costs that include applications, clinical competence assessment, bridging, exams and that could also include living allowance, transportation, and childcare. To be eligible, IENs must already live in Manitoba and must be pursuing registration/licensure with a Manitoba nursing regulator. Supports will be tailored to an individual's need and circumstance.
