The successful candidate will create content and attend filming sessions to record video modules and live masterclasses.

The successful candidate will serve as part of MomBrilliant's multidisciplinary team and collaborate with MomBrilliant's Program Development Manager and other pediatric specialists. The candidate will benefit from working from home, flexible hours, and a project-based salary with commission opportunities. Studio recordings in-person will occur (Location: Winnipeg, MB).

EDUCATION

- Provide mental health and wellness education within the scope of relevant professional standards to support community members in improving their well-being as it relates to mental health and parenting needs.
- Educate families in understanding and identifying postpartum depression.
- Provide mothers with coping exercises including mindfulness, grounding, and self-compassion.
- Provide mothers with education/resources related to health practices, illness prevention and navigation of the health care system to access health services.
- Provide evidence-based information to assist diverse mothers with various issues.













QUALIFICATIONS

- Graduate Degree in Counselling, Psychology, Psychiatric Nursing or Social Work from a Provincially authorized post-secondary program.
- Current registration/license in good standing with the applicable college.
- Minimum of two (2) years of recent professional experience related to maternal and child health promotion in an approved Mental Health Care setting.
- Completion of Child and Youth Care Program, Family Support Worker Certificate, or relevant education is an asset.
- Knowledge of Adult Learning and Behavior Change Principles is an asset.
- Working experience in instructional design and with instruc tional technology is an asset.
- Ability to write effective copy, instructional text, audio scripts/video scripts is an asset.
